Kentucky Bourbon Trail

5 Days/4 Nights

Day 1 - Today, travel to Franklin, TN for an overnight stay at the Drury Inn. Dinner is on your own this evening, but you can take advantage of the hotel's 5:30 Kickback featuring a rotating menu and cold beverages is served every evening from 5:30pm to 7:00pm.

Day 2 - Start the day with breakfast at the hotel. You will then depart for Kentucky. Your first stop today is a tour of the Jim Beam American Stillhouse in Clermont, KY. Get an up close and intimate look at Jim Beam Bourbon and how it's made. This guided tour will take you through the entire process, starting with the natural limestone water well and all the way through the mashing, distilling, barreling, aging, and bottling.

Continue travel this afternoon to Louisville, KY where you stay at the Drury Inn for the next two nights. Tonight, you enjoy a dinner aboard the Mary M. Miller Riverboat as you cruise on a beautiful stretch of the Ohio River. The Mary M. Miller is named after Louisvillian Mary Millicent Miller, who also happened to be the first woman to ever attain her steamboat captain's license way back in 1884.

Day 3 - Enjoy the hotel's breakfast before beginning your day with a guided tour in Horse Farm Country. You will visit the Shelbyville Kentucky area and horse farms such as Undulata Farms, with Saddlebred horses and Swallowland Farm with Icelandic horses.

Lunch today will at Claudia Sanders Dinner House. This restaurant is a replica of the elegant, old home opened by Colonel Sanders of KFC fame, in 1959. It was from this very building that Kentucky Fried Chicken grew into a world-wide organization.

This afternoon you take a guided Distillery Tour of Woodland Reserve. Learn about the history of bourbon, how they are unique at all five sources of flavor, the bottling process, and much more. At the end of the tour, guests 21 and over can taste the award-winning craft bourbon for themselves in the visitors' center.

Then tour the Wild Turkey Distillery. This "From Barrel to Bottle" tour leaves on the hour and includes an in depth visit to the distillery and the historic brickhouse, where barrels age. End your tour experience with a tasting.

Next, you spend late afternoon and evening at The Evan Williams Bourbon Experience. It is an artisanal distillery located in downtown Louisville on Whiskey row and celebrates the legacy of Evan Williams, Kentucky's first distiller. While here dinner is included in their Speakeasy.

Day 4 - After breakfast, you head to Lynchburg, TN. Once you arrive in Lynchburg, you will have time to have lunch on your own and a little time to browse the shops around the town square, before your scheduled time for Jack Daniel Tour. You might like to try BBQ Caboose Cafe on the Square or the Barrel House a block away.

Enjoy a tour of the Jack Daniel's Distillery. Let one of their seasoned storytellers guide you through Mr. Jack's distillery and old-time Tennessee whiskey-making process. Then, finish your trip with a memorable stop at their historic Barrel House. Here you'll linger over a sip five of their most popular whiskeys and liqueurs.

After your tour, you depart for Athens, AL. Here you check into the Hampton Inn for an overnight stay. This evening, dinner is included at the Cracker Barrel where you have a \$15.00 Gift Card you can use towards your meal.

Day 5 - Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before departing for home.
